- ".... Institutions who participate in the Collaboration are expected to give significant contributions to the construction and operation of the SuperB detector, including its computing systems, both hardware or software...."
- ".... The Membership Committee will assist the new group in negotiating possible terms of entry and will eventually report its recommendations at a Council meeting after the group has given a presentation about the composition, experience, proposed contribution to the experiment and current other commitments.
- The Council will subsequently vote on the applicants proposal and a qualified majority will be required to endorse it..."

New Institutions (II)

- Today we will here about the proposal, submitted by a few Mexican University groups, to join the SuperB Collaboration; they are supported by the Consejo Nacional de Ciencia y Tecnología (CONACyT)
- after a presentation Prof. Pedro Podesta (Universidad Autónoma de Sinaloa) we will hear the report of the Membership Office with the proposal tho be discussed and voted.



 The number of Council voting members is at this moment 46 excluding the ex-officio member

Spokesperon nomination

- "The Collaboration Council will appoint a Nominating Committee, consisting of eleven members, who will be responsible for nominating a Spokesperson ... one member from the Cabibbo-Lab, five members from INFN Institutions, and five members from at least four different non-Italian countries. ...
- The nomination will be presented to the Council, with a majority vote of all members, in person or by proxy, required for election. "

Collecting input...

- I asked the Executive Board, given its wide regional representation of the SuperB communities, to help the Council in selecting the best candidates for the job.
- Regional representatives were give the charge to consult internally and come up with one or two names
- the outcome (after some solicitation) was collected and it has been then pretty straightforward to compile a list based on the indications expressed by the collaboration
- th Cabibbo Lab also provided a name
