#### New Mexican Institutions

- first time the procedure described in our Constitution for new Institutions have been followed:
  - \* Five Mexican Institutions expressed interest in joining the collaboration
  - interactions with TB and Membership office took place to negotiate the possible contributions of the groups to the SuperB project
  - \* prof. Pedro Podesta, on behalf of the Mexican groups, presented the composition, experience, proposed contribution to the experiment and current other commitments at the Council meeting;
  - \* the Membership office recommended the admission of the five Mexican Institutions
  - x the Council approved the proposal with a qualfied majority vote

- areas of activities: IFR, computing, analysis
- total of ~ 10 Professor and Researchers (Alice, D0, CMS, Focus..)
- support already secured by the funding agency CONACYT (National council of science and Technology)
  - x 4.4 M \$MXN (244k Euros) per project (four years) approved
  - x application submitted for additional 0.5 M \$MXN for special projects
- ... and by the Universities:
  - x 150k-200k \$MXN (8-11k Euros) Univ. Funds for travel

## Spokesperson nomination

- The Collaboration Council will appoint a Nominating Committee, consisting of eleven members, who will be responsible for nominating a Spokesperson ... one member from the Cabibbo-Lab, five members from INFN Institutions, and five members from at least four different non-Italian countries. ...
- The nomination will be presented to the Council, with a majority vote of all members, in person or by proxy, required for election.

#### Setting up the Nominating Committee

- ◆ I asked the Executive Board, given its wide regional representation of the SuperB communities, to help the Council in selecting the best candidates for the job;
- Regional representatives were give the charge to consult internally and suggest one or two names;
- the outcome (after some solicitation) was collected and it has been then pretty straightforward to compile a list based on the indications expressed by the collaboration
- the Cabibbo Lab also provided a name
- Council approved the list of names proposed and the Committee has been appointed

- we encourage Institutions to put forward proposals to host the one or two meetings that may take place outside LNF in 2013
