### GENERAL INFORMATION

#### 1. HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

Registered participants shall promptly receive confirmation by e-mail of their hotel accommodation and travel arrangements. Please inform the conference secretariat if you are missing this confirmation.

#### 2. CONFERENCE FEE

The Conference fee for participants will be **400 €**. There will be no fee for companions. The fee will be reduced by 50% for participants spending not more than two nights at the Hotel.

Major currencies other than Euro will be accepted. The daily exchange rates will be applied.

The Conference fee will cover the cost of all social events and of a copy of the proceedings.

#### 3. TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

Participants are expected to reach La Thuile by private car or by the conference buses, connecting free of charge Geneva (CERN and Cointrin Airport) and Milano (Malpensa Airport) to the conference venue. There will be two buses scheduled at different times from Milano Malpensa Airport and one bus from Geneva.

Participants traveling by car are reminded that in the Aosta Valley it is mandatory to carry snow chains. Private cars can be parked in the Hotel garage, free of charge.

Participants arriving by plane and willing to use a conference bus are kindly requested to inform the secretariat by e-mail of all details of their planned journey (airline, flight number, arrival time).

There is no public transport from Geneva to La Thuile. Transport from Malpensa to Aosta and La Thuile is available by train and bus. Accordingly, we encourage people not making use of a conference bus to consider primarily flying to Milano Malpensa. This airport features many direct flights to European, American and Asian destinations.

Bus rides between the Planibel Hotel at La Thuile and Geneva or Malpensa airports take about 2h30'. The bus schedule is as follows:

### *Upon arrival Sunday, March 1*

11:00 1<sup>st</sup> bus departure **from Milano Malpensa**

14:00 2<sup>nd</sup> bus departure **from Milano Malpensa**

The meeting point is in front of a café located between the two exits of Terminal 1. In this area you will find a conference poster and you will meet a conference staff member one hour before bus departure (i.e. 10:00 am for the bus leaving at 11:00 am and 1:00 pm for the bus leaving at 2:00 pm).

13.30 Bus departure **from CERN** to Geneva Airport

14:00 Bus continuation **from Geneva Airport** to La Thuile

The meeting point at CERN is at the PIO Visitors car park, close to the COOP Cafeteria in the Main Building. The meeting point at Geneva airport is at the Arrivals gate. A staff member holding a Conference poster will be easily recognized.
