We are pleased to announce the **opening of the registration** to the conference "eXtreme19" that will be held at the University of Padova, close to the heart of the historical city, on January 22-25, 2019.

The conference aims at gathering together scientists from different fields, mainly astronomy, cosmology, astroparticle, and fundamental physics. The main purpose is to review the present experimental and theoretical knowledge of particle acceleration and multi-messenger emission from these extreme accelerators, discussing their potential roles in modern cosmology and fundamental physics.

The meeting will cover the following topics:

- Extreme blazars and the blazar family
- Mechanisms of particle acceleration and radiation in jets
- Extreme blazars as neutrino factories
- Extreme blazars and the connection with the highest energy cosmic rays
- Cosmology and fundamental physics
- Future observatories

The deadline for abstract submission for both posters and oral contributions is fixed to October 31st, 2018.

Venue:

The meeting will take place in Padova, at the "Polo Multifunzionale di Psicologia" - Via Venezia, 8 - Italy.

With more than 210.000 inhabitants and some 60.000 students, the bustling city of Padova, also known as Padua in English, is nowadays a pleasant destination for culture-, arts- and history-based tourism.

It has been founded well before Roman times and since then has played a pivotal role in the Veneto region as a market and as a cultural center. This long history is well testified by the numerous touristic attractions within the city, from ancient roman ruins to medieval walls and cobble-stone streets, from Renaissance cathedrals and churches to modern building and museums. Gems are the *Scrovegni* Chapel painted by Giotto, the *Basilica of S. Anthony* with its cloisters, statues and paintings and the *Palazzo della Ragione* that hosts a covered market, as well as many other historical and beautiful buildings and squares such as *Prato della Valle*. Padova is also home to several restaurants, bars, and shops that make it very lively, especially during the warm season.

Due to its geographical location, Padova is an ideal basis to visit nearby artistic cities, such as Venice, Verona, Vicenza and Ferrara.
