- Training?
 - Software Carpentry and Data Carpentry coordinators in UK
 - Train to be instructors
 - Deliver training courses
 - Also training on good software development practice / sustainability
 - · Currently aimed at UK PhD students in Centres for Doctoral Training
 - Contribute to Summer Schools?
- Internships?
 - Could "shadow" staff at sites
 - But may not have ideal matches for projects
- Issues?
 - SSI is a multi-university collaboration: which site? Edinburgh?
 - Potential finance issues if students need to be registered at institution, but probably not if just providing training/internships as project partner?
 - Overlap with SCF for training? We can agree with SCF who is the appropriate lead partner.
