### GENERAL INFORMATION

#### 1. HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

Registered participants shall receive confirmation by e-mail of their hotel accommodation and travel arrangements. Please inform the conference secretariat if you are missing this confirmation.

#### 2. CONFERENCE FEE

The Conference fee for participants will be **430 €**. There will be no fee for companions. The fee will be reduced by 50% for participants spending not more than two nights at the Hotel. Major currencies other than Euro will be accepted. The daily exchange rates will be applied.

#### 3. TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

Participants arriving by car can use, free of charge, the Hotel parking.

**8. OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES**

The Conference venue is a few steps from the start of the sky slopes. The Instructors of la Thuile Sky School organize special classes for the Conferences. Usually we have three classes: beginners, medium level and advanced skiers. Classes are free of charge but we request that **interested** people inform us. There are other possibilities: from cross-country sky (there are several paths in La Thuile), to paths for walking with snowshoes so that you can enjoy the spectacular views of the area.

We remind you that main shops renting sky equipment have special discounts for Conference participants upon presentation of their conference badge.

**9. SKI PASSES**

The participants in the Rencontres will be able to purchase sky passes at a reduced rate at the cable car ticket gates. The Secretariat of the Rencontres will issue the required certificates. No photograph will be needed.

Skipass can be acquired at discounted price. We remind that insurance for outdoor activities can be bought along with skipasses. Based on past experiences, if you intend using your personal insurance, make sure that it covers the activities you want to pursue.
