# Rotation of roles

- Responsible for Safety and Protection:
  - Marco Tobia since January 1<sup>st</sup> 2017

### LNGS Status - 1

- Maintenance and Operation
  - Main Contractor for M&O services turned out to be quite unreliable
  - We suffered several delays on deliveries
  - We are struggling to legally overcome several problems
  - Contract will be terminated on April 2018 at the latest

#### LNGS Status - 2

- Quake of January 18 mainly produced non-structural damage to a few buildings.
- Close inspection of Lab-1 (OPERA building) revealed problems not related to quake
  - quality problems, which are being quantitatively addressed
- Lab-1 may need to be closed for intervention for several months

## Incident

- Traces of DCM (0.3  $\mu$ g/l) were detected by health authorities in water on August 31 at pit 62 (near UG-Lab main entrance)
- In spite of the contamination being 60 times below the threshold for drinkable water recommended by WHO, it triggered an alert from health authorities
- By end September the incident was closed
- But it was resurfaced by media in December
- ...and now again

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## **Enforcement of rules**

- Operations must be announced and approved
- Chemicals must be declared, SDS provided, and authorized
- Fluids must be declared and authorized
- Storage of chemicals is not allowed UG
- Radioactive sources
  - Allowed UG only when in use
  - The person who make the request for a sorce must be the person who uses the source
