 - Will take time to assimilate changes
- Strategy for supporting DGWG
- Need better user support
 - release tools, software distribution, computing infrastructure, user packages, ...
 - Listed in WBS, needs are ~immediate

BaBar Software in SuperB

- Requested release of 'core' software still pending
 - Needs better followup from my side
- DGWG, Physics reach studies need access to sophisticated BaBar tools
 - tagging, BReco, $B \rightarrow \tau v$, ...
 - This has been a sensitive issue
 - BaBar+Belle collaboration may make this easier
- We need a schedule for a first offline release
 - Warwick appears to be too early
