Practical Information

Welcome to Lecce!

In the following you can find some useful information for your staying.

Moving around Lecce: Lecce is a fairly small city, so the best way to move around is on foot. For longer distances within the city, it has an efficient bus system. A single ticket can be purchased either at the *Edicola* and *Tabacchi* shops (they are shops where newspapers and cigarets are respectively sold) with a price of 1 euro, or directly on the bus for 1.50 euros. The ticket needs to be validated on board and has a validity of 90 minutes. The buses accept cash only, and preferably the correct amount. Do not forget to purchase a ticket. Together with the single ticket it is possible to purchase: 24 hours tickets (cost: 2.50 euro – the duration is counted since its validation and allows for unlimited rides within the following 24 hours); multicorse (several rides – it costs 5 euro and allows for 6 rides); Weekly ticket (9.70 euro – it is valid within the week when it is validated). 
