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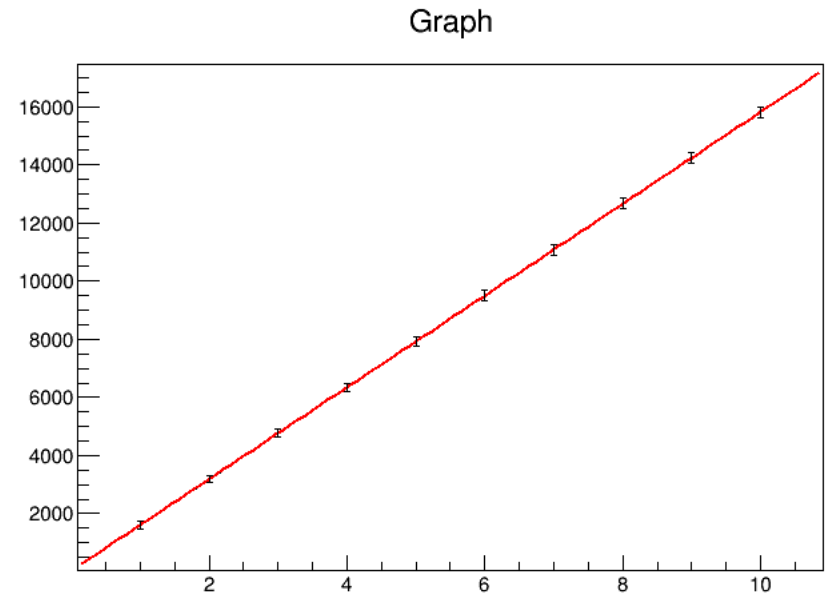
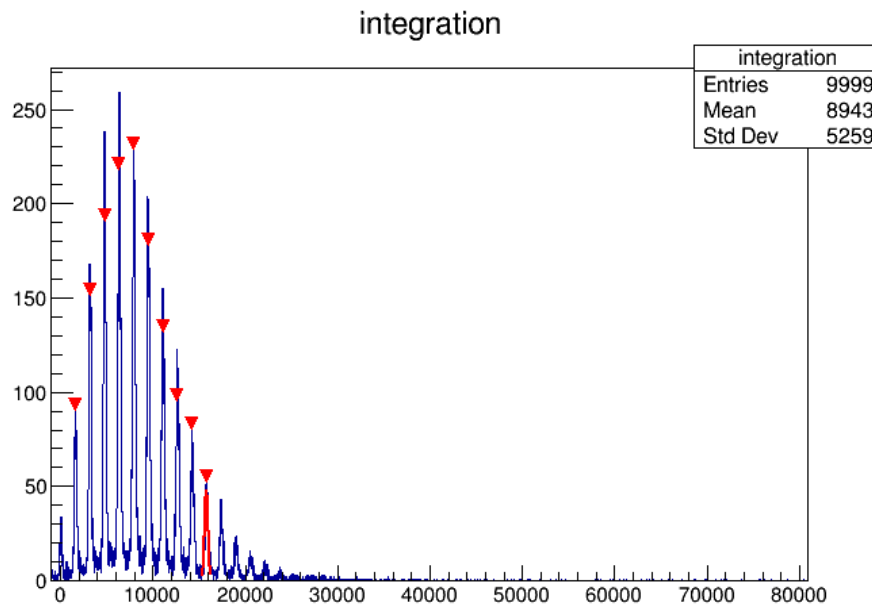

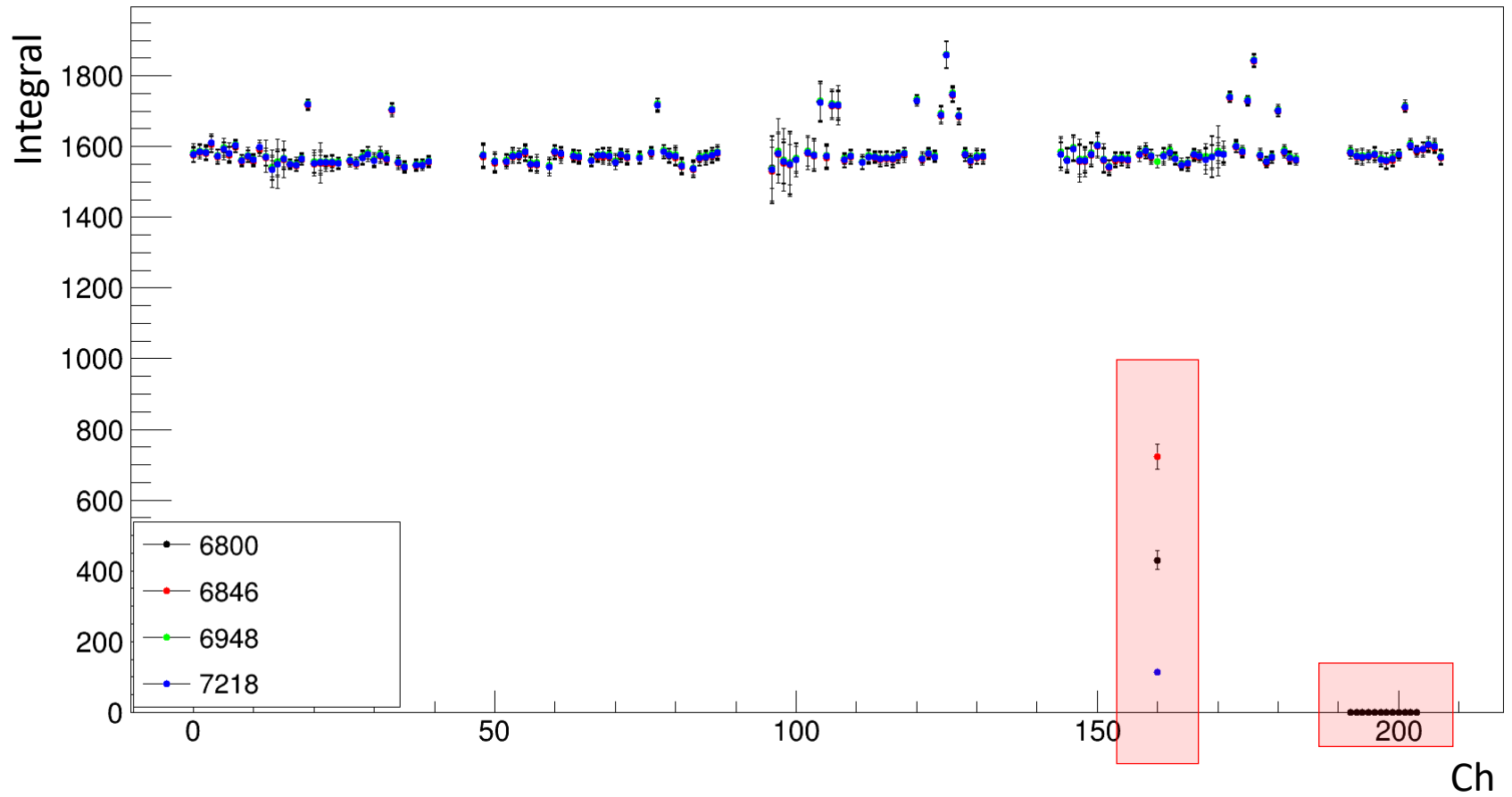

SensL channel calibration

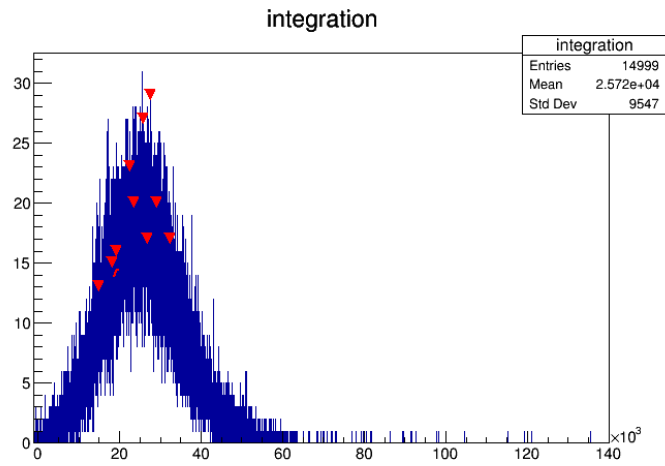
- Taking distributions from preprocessed data

- Linear regression to find out calibration



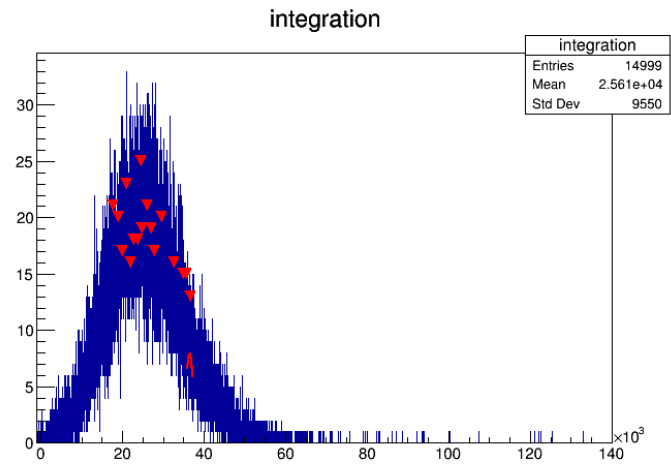

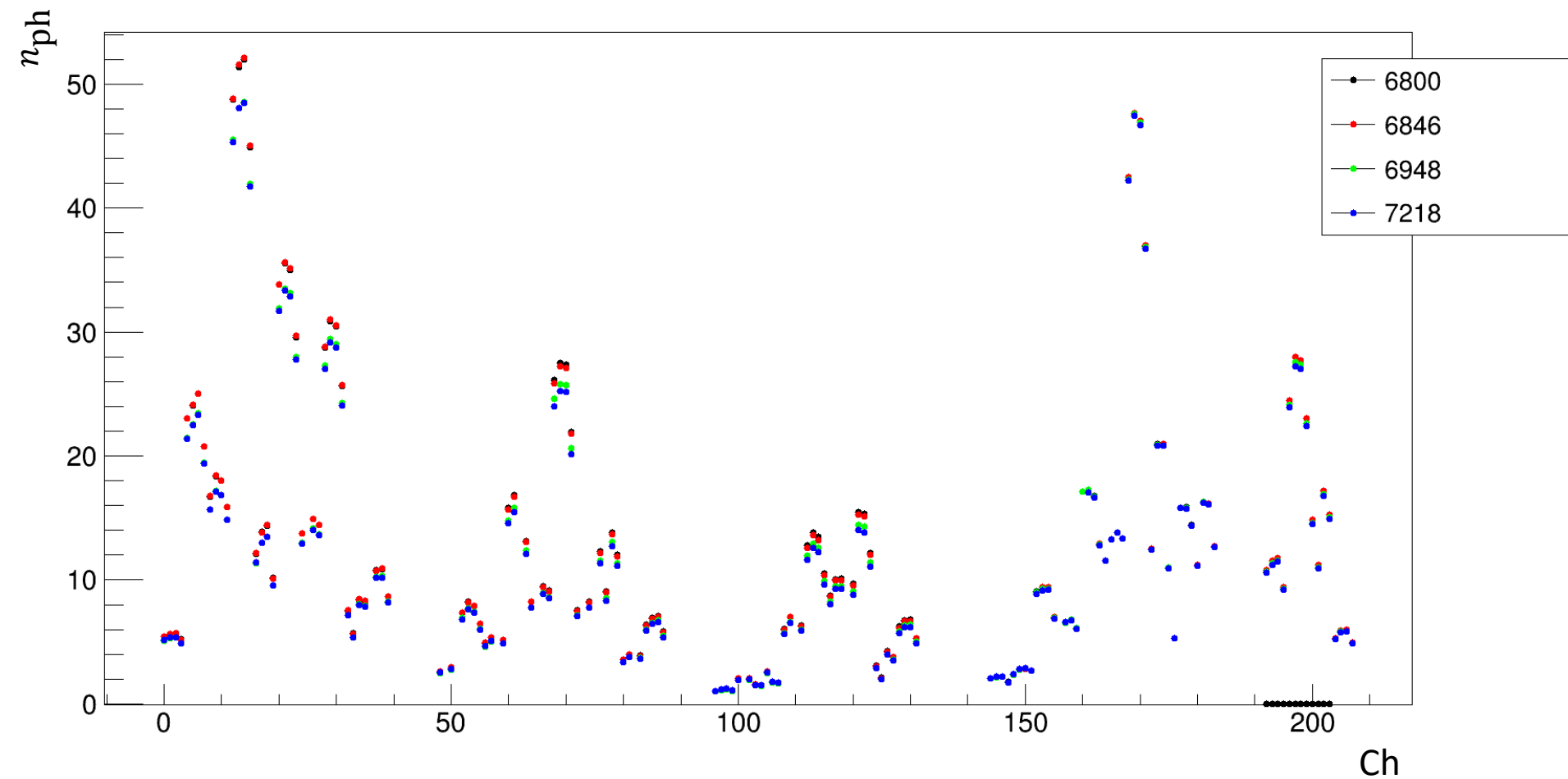


Light collection

- $n_{\text{ph}} = \text{Mean} / \text{Gain}$



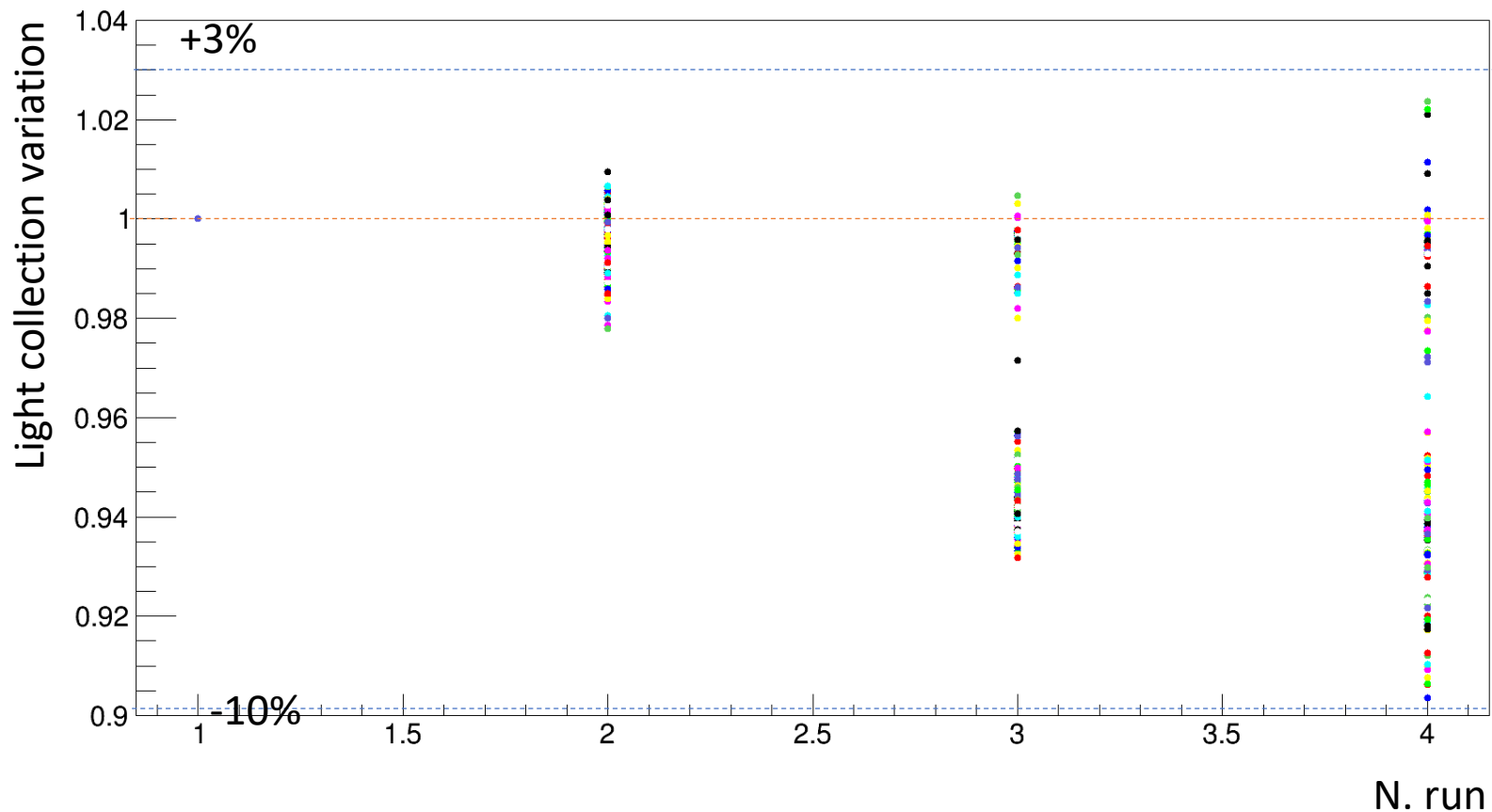

- Let's consider the ratio:

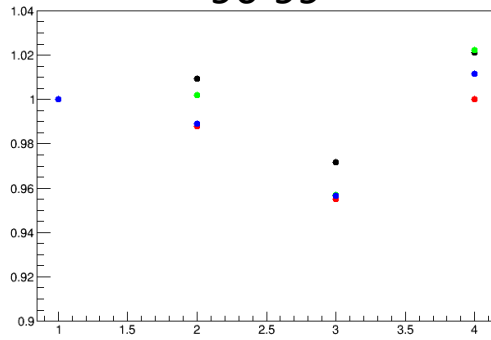

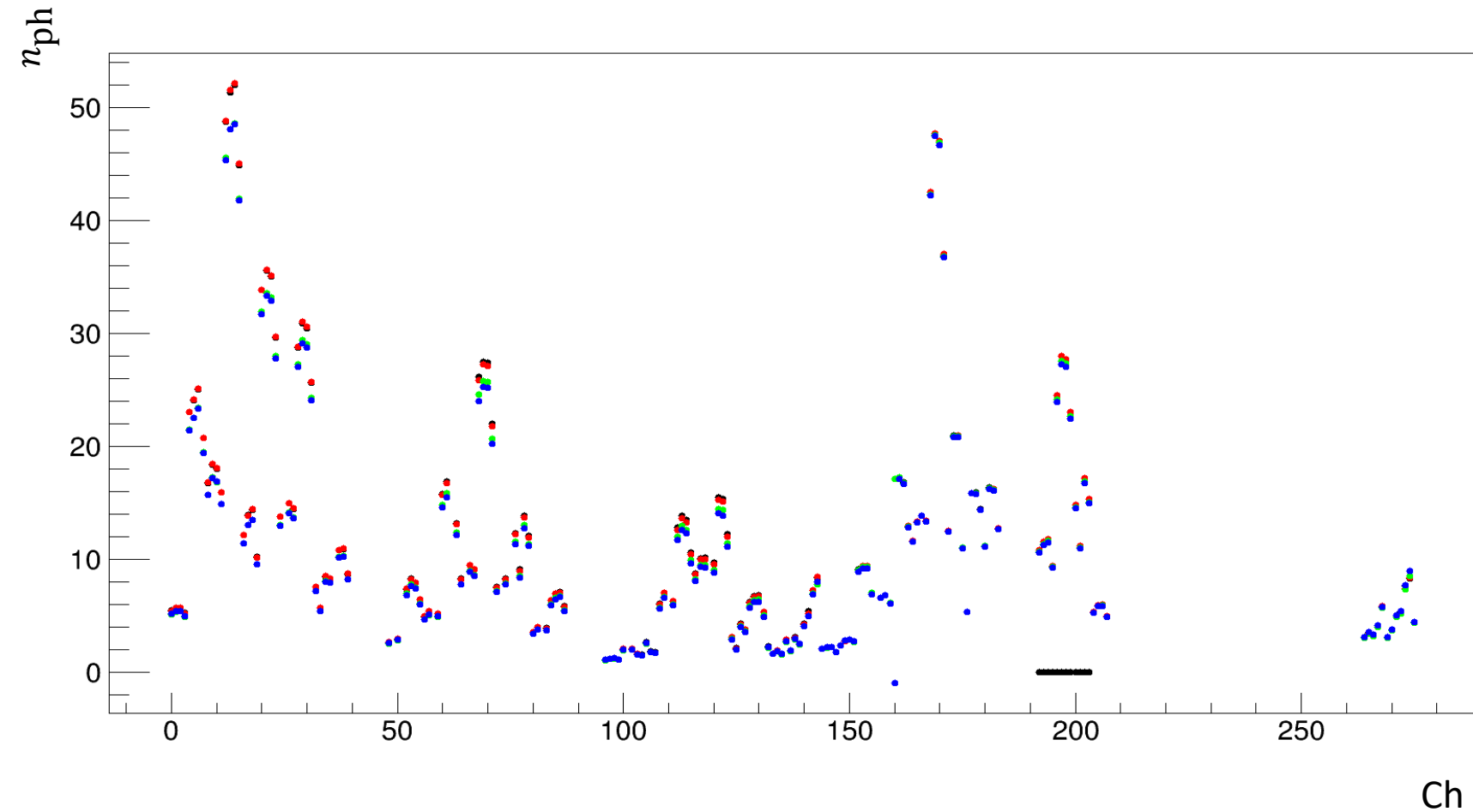
Gain vs time – Arapuca 1



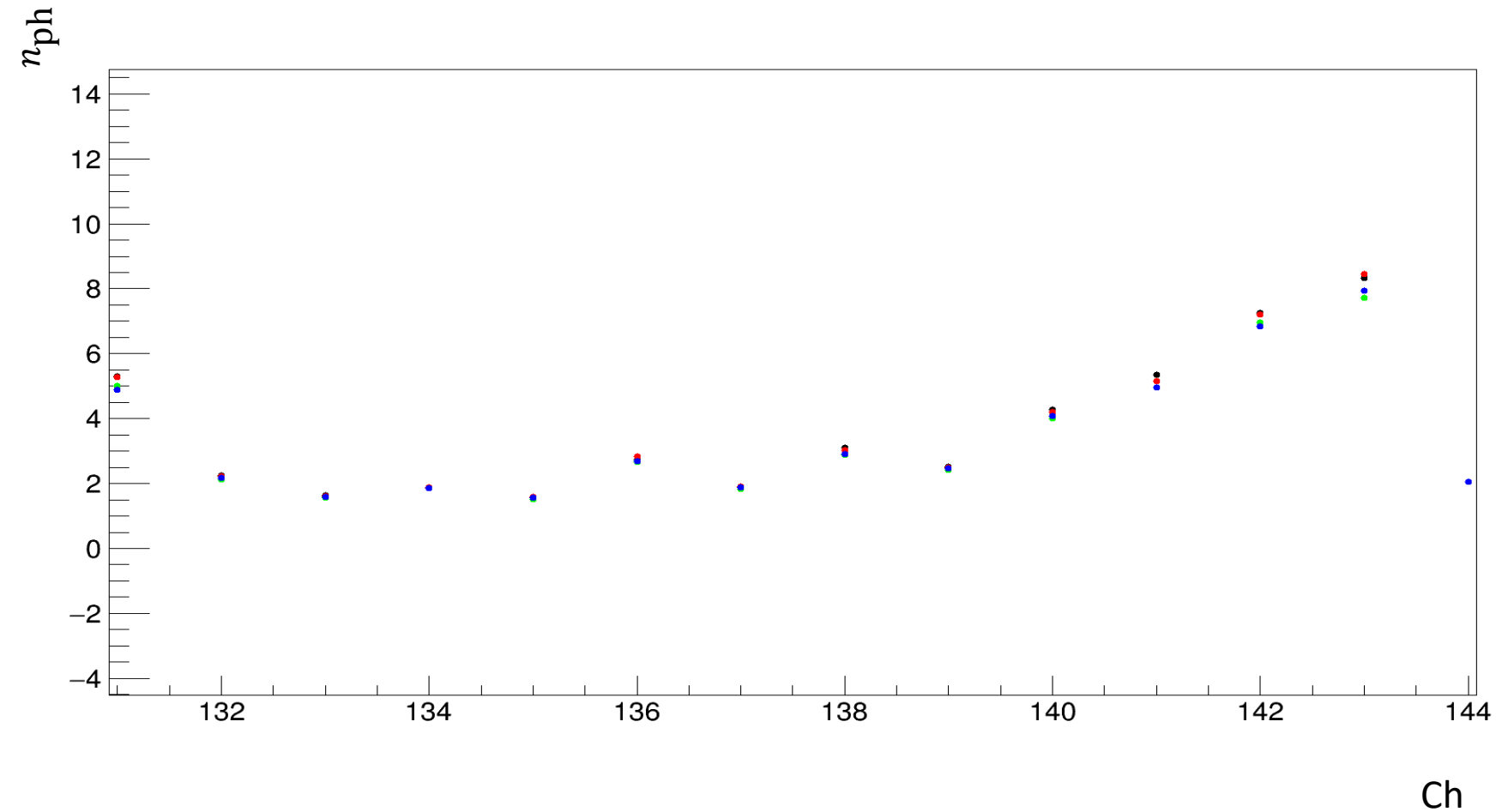
