The proceedings for "XV Workshop on Resistive Plate Chambers and Related Detectors - RPC2020" held on 10-14 February, 2020 in Rome, Italy, will be published in the Proceedings Section of JINST, Journal of Instrumentation.

To prepare your contribution for submission, please use the JINST Proceedings templates at http://jinst.sissa.it/jinst/help/JINST_TeXclass.jsp

Kindly notice that the number of pages should not exceed 8 pages for the keynote talks, 6 pages for the oral contributions and 4 pages for the posters (excluding the first page and the reference list)

When writing your contribution, in addition to the scientific quality and relevance of the subject matter, it is advisable also to check the quality of formatting, language and style (i.e. incoherent use of unit of measure; different conventions used in the same paper such as abbreviations 3 s'', 3 sec'', 3 seconds'' and position: 3C'', 3 C''; poorly organized tables; etc.)

When your contribution is ready for submission, please follow the instructions below:

- 1. Connect to http://jinst.sissa.it and register;
- 2. in the "Submit" section of the page select the link "submit a proceedings contribution" (see attached screenshot 1);
- 3. select the RPC2020 conference from the list (see attached screenshot 2);
- 4. follow the step-by-step procedure for submission, referring to the instructions available in the section "For Authors" at the top of the JINST home page (<u>http://jinst.sissa.it/jinst/help/helpLoader.jsp?pgType=author</u>).

Please we invite you to submit your contribution firstly to Arxiv (physics.ins-det).

Kindly make sure you submit your RPC2020 contribution by April 30th, 2020.
