
The seismometers are usually mounted on a hardrock tile (attached to the ground with concrete) and covered by an acoustic insulating cover. A thermal insulating box filled with insulation foam is then placed on top of the instrument to further isolation the instrument from external influences.

LABVIEW MEASUREMENT INTERFACE (SIMILAR TO HOMESTAKE)



Seismic data acquisition is done using a National instruments DAQmx card (PCI 6289) in a PC mounted into a 19 inch portable flight case. LabView is used to create control, monitor and acquisition software specific to the seismometer. The seismometer signals are amplified and filtered by and external amplifier before being read by the DAQ. Sampling is done at 128 Hz. The least significant bit input voltage of ~80 nV results in a seismic noise sensitivity of ~ 6.5e-11 m/s. Below the low noise model from DC - 20 Hz.
