- Prague selected as ICHEP2020 venue in 2016
- Preparations running till spring 2020, then switched to online mode due to COVID
- Regular C11 reporting (many old slides in backup)
- Another opportunity provided by C11 decision to assign 2024 edition to Prague "again"
- Large part of preparatory work to be reused (including one chair)

 - Active vs passive






