LHCP Location

► LHCP aims to rotate around three regions in a four-year cycle

- Europe → Americas → Europe → Asia and Oceania; African venues can bid in any phase of the cycle
- Competitive bidding process typically 3-4 very strong bids each year
- Venue for LHCP-(N+2) selected at the IAC meeting at LHCP-N




Online LHCP 2022

- ▶ Planning until Feb 2022 for hybrid edition
 - Optional excursion on Saturday and full scientific program on Mon-Fri
 - More family friendly format
 - Online program kept as backup
 - Fallback to online edition due to restrictive quarantine upon arrival in Taiwan
- ► Thanks to IUPAP and CERN support, no-fee attendance possible again
- ► Mainly followed the conference structure used in Paris
 - More work for local hosts from Taipei managing zoom sessions
 - Talks scheduled Mon-Fri 12.00-18.30 CEST with two 15' breaks
 - Parallel sessions with seven-fold parallelism
 - Poster session split into a (European) morning and evening session
 - o presenters specified for which session(s) they would be present
- ▶ Indico and zoom used for the entire conference
 - All sessions recorded, with explicit consent given by speakers
 - Live closed-captioning by a commercial company for all plenary sessions
 - Better fidelity over automatic captioning
 - Successful experiment using gathertown for virtual poster venue


Geographical distribution of participants
