






Status





- Chosen the Agency, NOEMA, that will work with us on the organisation of ICHEP 2022
- ICHEP 2022 is being organised in "mixed" format: both in person and online participation
 - Conditions allowing in person participation will be clearly favoured
- Signed contract with Bologna Congressi for the Venue
 - Important condition: can terminate contract until end of January 2022 without penalty
- Defined the LOC, with ~70 colleagues from Bologna and Ferrara (INFN + University)
- Defined the IAC
- Signed contract with a company for the realisation of the ICHEP 2022 website
- Conference Logo will be defined through a public competition. Deadline 15/12/2021
- Will organise a large outreach event, possibly in the main square of Bologna, Piazza Maggiore
- INFN Sponsorship already received
- IUPAP Sponsorship has been granted
- Several other Institutional sponsors have pledged an economic sponsorship





- February: invitation plenary speakers (IAC)
- 10 of March: close abstract submission and start of selection
- End of March: definition talks list
- April: definition speakers list

The selected agency is **Noema**, company from Bologna with a broad experience in organising events of many different kinds, also of very large dimensions.


Noema has already worked with INFN Bologna (ISMD 2014, CMS week 2009).

POLO CONGRESSUALE – GROUND FLOOR


