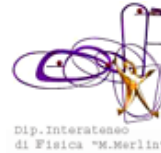

Stefano Augelli Born on December 13, 1986 in Bari. On September 2000 he was admitted to attend the class of piano at the “Niccolò Piccinni” academy of music in Bari under the leadership of M° G. He is attending the first course of II level academic degree under the leadership of M° Pasquale Iannone and he is improving his piano competences with Marisa Somma. At the age of eleven he entered, for the first time, a piano national competition “Città di Casamassima” obtaining the third prize. He won the first prize at the national competitions “Città di Palombaio” (1999) and “Città di Casamassima” (2000) and the second prize at the international competition “Città di Camerino” (2010). He has been a member of the Youth Symphony Orchestra as pianist from 2003 to 2008 playing in many towns (Bari, Altamura, Andria, Casamassima, Gioia del Colle, Gravina in Puglia, Mottola, Noicattaro, Pisa, Putignano, Sammichele di Bari, Spinazzola, Taranto, Toritto, Torre a mare, Trani, Triggiano e Turi). He took part in Mola summer season 2010 “Moonlight Concerts” playing pieces of Beethoven, Chopin, Mussorgsky. In summer 2011 he performed several chamber music concerts with the Harmonie Orchestra playing some own arrangements for strings and piano of film music.

Marzia Antonella Scelsi was born in Bari in 1989. She has been studying piano since the age of nine with professors Patrizia Gesuita and Maria Carmela Panebianco. Currently she is going to take a first level graduation in Physics at University in Bari and at the same time she is attending the eighth course at the Conservatoire "Niccolò Piccinni" under the guide of Professor Filippo Balducci. She performs as soloist, in duos and with opera singers, taking regularly part in students' concerts at the "M. Merlin" Dept. of Physics; she also attends workshops and masterclasses in Italy and Switzerland with professors Angela Montemurro and Igor Longato, always participating in final concerts.

Fabio Deelan Cunden, born in Bari on March 8, 1988, graduated with laude and special mention in 2010 at the Conservatory "N. Piccinni" in the class of M^o Filippo Balducci. He attended master classes with F. J. Thiollier, I. Longato, A. Montemurro and J. Soriano. He has participated in numerous national and international music competitions where he always stood out for its technical and musical qualities: he won the first prize at the National Competition "N. Van Westernout" Mola di Bari, first prize at the VII National Contest "Euterpe" di Corato, at the VIII European Competition "Pietro Argento", Gioia del Colle, and the International Competition of "EurOrchestra Bari "; at the IX National Contest "Fratres "Monteroni di Lecce he won the special prize for the best musical interpretation. In 2009, he graduated with Degree in Physics at the University of Bari, and he is currently enrolled in the Master of Science in Physics at the University of Bari.

Nilla Pappadopoli conducts the Harmonie Orchestra (the String Orchestra performing this evening). She earned a full degree as a pianist in the Bari Conservatorio N.Piccinni in 1987. At present she is principal conductor of the Harmonie Orchestra, bandleader of the Grande Banda Lirico-Sinfonica Nino Rota Città di Bari (Official Band of the City of Bari), the Apulia Felix Choir. As President of the Musical Association Musical Culture Diffusion Committee of Mola di Bari she manages the Musical Season "Concerti al
