What we think worked well

Participation: ~80 registered, an average of 60 in the room during all of the sessions

Discussion: all talks in time, each session significantly out of time → lively and genuine discussion, also with questions meant to really improve understanding

Structure: 2.5 days, executive intro talk when felt necessary, 20+5 talks, 6/7 talks/session \rightarrow

freedom to fine-tune the organisation in each session proved fruitful

Design: italian-contributed intensity-frontier experiments, limit perspectives and discuss stringent problems / challenges

Self-congratulatory apparatus

What we think might be improved

SC structure: improve it to better follow the effort and implement deadlines

Timing: we started and converged with the workshop structure and gave the final announcement **too late (linked to the previous point)**: in-advance interaction with speakers to fine tune the contributions had not been possible

Detector-related contributions: while avoiding a dedicated session, it is worth considering physics-driven hardware contributions specific to each session

Young researchers: an additional half-day session might be dedicated to early-career contributions, still featuring proceedings → BTW, please follow the instructions to prepare/submit the proceedings to THIS edition

Discussion: should check in advance the availability of a blackboard also for the future
