
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

Palazzo Ducale


- Our main room is Sala del Minor Consiglio

Things to do in Genova city centre and surroundings

- Plenty of restaurants and bars in the historic centre or Porto Antico and nearby areas
- You have a city map with some tourism directions in your welcome kit
- Check out <u>visitgenoa.it</u> and download the free app Visit Genoa
- The city centre is mostly a pedestrian area and it is huge; worth to explore and please ask for tips on things you cannot miss
- Vicoli are charming but also require some level of alertness... at night, don't get lost and don't take your laptop out!

Public transportation in Genova

- When using buses, metro, cable-carts and lifts, a good option is to buy tickets in advance at newsagents or vending machines (e.g. at metro stations)
- More details on the <u>AMT website</u> (italian only, sorry), but the main options are single tickets (2 euro / 110') or <u>weekly passes</u> (22 euro)
- Some bus stops (e.g. Piazza De Ferrari) are equipped with contactless option, called ILA (Instant Lane Access)
- You can also download the AMT Genova app, which can be used to monitor transits and buy tickets via phone (Biglietti→Biglietto via SMS) or Credit Card (Biglietti→Biglietto con carta di credito)

How to get to Banano Tsunami (Porto Antico)

Less than 10 mins walk from Palazzo Ducale to the welcome drink venue

Some info on the welcome drink @ Banano Tsunami

- To get your food and drink voucher, just show your badge (also for +1s)
- Drinks:
- spritz cocktail or white wine to share plus
- one cocktail of your choice among Negroni / Gin tonic / White Sangria
- Finger food: we informed the venue about your dietary choices / restrictions
- Vegans and vegetarians: simply declare your choice when getting your food
- alternatives include more bruschette and fried food instead of seafood

Some info on the welcome drink @ Banano Tsunami

- People with allergies:
- the place is **not equipped to grant 100% non-contamination**, but...
- Alternatives will be anyway available for you to consider:
- more bruschette also in this case
- no fried food, to avoid contamination with seafood through oil
- trofie al pesto (contains pine nuts) will be available
