## **ENOLOGY**

Vinification starts after a manual harvest in crates, with immediate stalk removal. Next, four pump overs are carried out each day for the first week and the maceration lasts eight days. After the racking, decantering and the malolactic fermentation have occurred, the wine is then aged in different aged French barriques tor 18 months. Bottled in August 2020.

## TASTING NOTE

*Argamakow* Langhe DOC Pinot Noir is a wine that can be drunk when still young or left to age for ten to fifteen years. To be served at a temperature between sixteen and eighteen degrees, it is a smooth, fragrant, pleasantly tannic wine.

## **FOOD PAIRINGS**

It's ideally paired with first courses (pasta and rice dishes), meat, cheese and cold meats, but it can be also paired with fish.
