Grant types

- Short-Term Scientific Mission grant
 - Support the mobility of scientists, evaluated on quantized basis
 - Evaluations on quantized basis
- ITC Conference grant
 - Participation of members from ITC in events
 - Evaluated continuously
- Dissemination Conference grant
 - Represent the action activities at high profile conferences
 - Prerogative of Action Chair approval i.e. not reviewed by Grant Awarding Committee
- Virtual Networking Support
- Virtual Mobility grant

- Aimed for transparent decision policy, documented as much as possible
 - The policy was not much used in 2023 due to limited interest
 - Increased interest and evaluation work in 2024
- Limited budget i.e. priorities are set
 - Young scientists
 - No permanent position
 - Lower number of successful grants within the action
- Fill up to the in-advance decided budget

• Three calls for STSM during the accounting period

- Usually the successful candidates are approved for a support of ~500 euros/week
 - Many requests had to undergo a reduction

Applications: summary

- Short-Term Scientific Mission grant
 - Success rate: 57 %, \sim 1/3 of the requested funds were granted
 - Funds allocated: 13400
- ITC Conference grants
 - 2 applications towards the end of the accounting period for conferences in September
 - Total requested funds 2700
 - Funds alocated 2000
 - Conference taxes increased: 400-500 euro
 - 1000 per conference per participant
- Total amount awarded by the Grant Awarding Committee: **15400** (out of 13000 foreseen)

School participation

- Part of the grant awarding to individual participants
 - Undergoes evaluation bu the Grant Awarding Committee
 - Proper evaluation took place in 2024 due to increased interest in the school
 - GAC provides recommendation

 - Respecting the alocated budget

 - 24 selected (divided into two priority classes, i.e. ordering proposed)
