SECOND ANNOUNCEMENT and CALL FOR PAPERS

Purpose of the Conference

HIAT is an international conference dealing with heavy ion accelerators and their components, including their design, realization, test and operation.

It focuses on: operational experience on existing facilities, achievements in heavy ion accelerator physics and technology, progress on the implementation of approved projects and their infrastructures, trends in the proposal and design of heavy ion accelerators and their main systems and components.

The conference is mainly devoted to the accelerator teams of any institution, laboratory or university, running or developing heavy ion facilities or their components for studies in the fields of nuclear physics and astrophysics as well as the applications of heavy ion beams in medicine, accelerator mass spectrometry, material analysis and processing, nuclear waste management, dynamics of nuclear fusion and fission, radiation science and dosimetry, development and production of radionuclides, environmental metrology, etc.

HIAT 2009 is the 11th in a series of conferences, going back to 1973 in Daresbury and followed by Strasbourg (1977), Oak Ridge (1981), Buenos Aires (1985), Strasbourg-Heidelberg (1989), Legnaro (1992), Canberra (1995), Argonne (1998), Delhi (2002), Brookhaven (2005).

Call for Papers

Authors are invited to submit abstracts on the topics characterizing the Conference. Oral and poster presentations will be selected on the basis of abstract submission.

The deadline for the submission of abstracts to HIAT09 is: Friday, 23 January, 2009.

Guidelines to submit abstracts

Abstracts can be submitted by linking at the "Call for Abstracts" page on HIAT09 web site (http://hiat09.lnl.infn.it/). To submit an abstract you have to register as INDICO user. Indico is the event management software used by INFN. When you click on "Submit a new abstract" you will be redirected to the Indico registration page: if you are already an Indico user you will be asked to insert your Indico username and password; if not, you will be asked to register.

Abstract Title

Enter the title of the abstract using capital letters. For example: "THIS IS A PAPER TITLE IN CAPITAL LETTERS"

Abstract Content

Text should not exceed 1500 characters. Since electronic submission over the web does not allow a simple, straight-forward system to enter Greek symbols, superscripts or subscripts, authors are requested to avoid using them. Some simple symbols can be typed according to the hints contained in http://hiat09.lnl.infn.it/instructions/symbols.html.

Presentation Type

Select "Poster" if you prefer to present a poster. Select "Oral" if you would be willing to make an oral presentation or you have been invited to do so.

Primary Authors and Co-Authors

Please, enter the primary author(s) and the co-authors. E-mail address for the primary author is mandatory. Indicate also who will be the presenter.

Track Classification

Authors are invited to classify their abstracts so that, if accepted for presentation, the paper is properly placed within the conference program.

Once the abstract submission form is complete, click "Submit".

Notification of the acceptance of contributions for presentation at the Conference will be made to all primary authors early in March 2009.

Proceedings

The Proceedings of HIAT09 will be published on JACoW (http://jacow.org/), the Joint Accelerator Conference Website for the Asian, European and American Particle Accelerator Conferences and the BIW, COOL, CYCLOTRONS, DIPAC, ECRIS, FEL, HIAT, ICALEPCS, ICAP, ICFA ABDW, LINAC, PCaPAC, RuPAC and SRF conferences. The proceedings will be available on the JACoW site after the conference.

Contributed oral presentations and poster presentations may be up to **5 pages** long. The deadline for the submission of final contributions to the Proceedings is **Thursday**, **June 4**, **2009**.

The Proceedings will be prepared electronically: guidelines and templates for the preparation and electronic submission of contributions will be published on HIAT09 web site.



The electronic files of contributions to the Proceedings will be processed prior to and during the conference and authors will be promptly informed about their acceptance.

The HIAT09 Conference will be held at Centro Culturale Don Orione Artigianelli, Venezia (Italy), from 8 to 12 June 2009.
