


Activities

ET Collaboration Member's Affiliation Map








ET structure

- Whenever you give talks related to ET it would be nice to write your RU name alongside your institute

(My) Take-home message

- The collaboration it is still in its infancy so things may not be so clear
- Moreover, many of us come from a different background (particle physics, condensed matter)...
- While some areas are advancing steadily (e.g.
 interferometer optical layout) some are still trying to
 converge on a more structured path (like coatings,
 suspensions, control etc)
- Task forces have been created and will be created to help focus the efforts (=be patient)



(My) Take-home message

- Ongoing competition among ET potential host sites (with heated discussion)
- As a collaboration we still have to decide where to build one triangle or two Ls
- As long as the competition goes on, it is difficult for some people to commit to ET (this RU included)

- Both current spokeperson, Michele Punturo (INFN PG), and Collaboration Board Chair, Eugenio Coccia (IFAE, GSSI), will finish their mandate within a year. Start thinking about candidates
