following up on the discussion we had at KEK, I found the following drawing in the "VTRx+ Application Note":




Figure 6: VTRx+ module plugged onto its host board.

The same document says that the host board connector is Hirose DF40C-(2.0)-40DS-0.4V.

The related datasheet https://www.hirose.com/en/product/document?clode=&productname=&series=DF40&documenttype=Catalog&lang=en&documentid=en_DF40_CAT already shows that there are different host connector heights available, and apparently the 3D CAD model had the wrong one.

(In Vienna, we have also equipped a higher one (4.0mm stacking height) onto our test board as well as the Dual-lpGBT board, because that was written in the CERN BOM for the test board.)

Even though in principle we can use any height, I think it is smarter to stick to the compact 2mm version. In the part number, the stacking height is the one in brackets.

Those connectors (2.0mm stacking height) are in stock at both Mouser and Digikey.
