## 16 April 2008 – CTF meeting

- server eventually arrived in the expected configuration last week, today it's being installed, SVN and repositories should be setup by the end of this week
- Yum repository (SL46) is active on the temporary server; instructions on how to use it were given to Eugenio; once he checked that everything works OK then the system could be made public (on the final machine)
- access to SVN through Ferrara LDAP server was successfully tested; presumably that was not yet the LDAP production server, but once the latter is ready, it should just be a matter of updating the link to use it. Obviously users should at that point be defined
- for the SVN usage policy, what prepared by David represents a very good starting point; I would suggest to setup two repositories, one for GEANT4 and one for the fast simulation. As David suggests we could start with a trunk+tags+branches structure, with the idea of using for the moment only the trunk for developments.
- repository creation is not open at the moment, but it can be requested by E-mail message; later we will think about a tool that provides remote repository creation
- a question: which SL distribution should we support for the moment via yum? SL51 too? for the moment there is no plan to support 64-bit versions
- we would need an entry in the SuperB Wiki site to insert some documentation,
