



## **5<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Charged Lepton Flavor Violation (CLFV2026)**

### **June 17-19 2026 – Sapienza University of Rome, Rome (Italy)**

Dear Colleagues,

We are pleased to announce that the **5<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Charged Lepton Flavor Violation (CLFV2026)** will be held in **Rome, Italy**, from **June 17<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026**, at **Sapienza University of Rome**.

The conference is organized by INFN Sezione di Roma and the Department of Physics of Sapienza University of Rome, in collaboration with the INFN Laboratori Nazionali di Frascati. It will feature invited plenary talks, starting on Wednesday, June 17<sup>th</sup> (morning), and concluding on Friday, June 19<sup>th</sup> (late afternoon). The scientific program will also include a poster session. A selection of posters will be invited for short flash talks, with a particular emphasis on contributions from young researchers.

The scientific program will focus on searches for **charged lepton flavor violation**, covering:

- the theoretical status and prospects of CLFV models;
- recent experimental results and their impact on the theoretical landscape;
- future opportunities offered by upcoming and next-generation experiments.

## Abstract submission

Abstract submission for posters will open on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2026 and close on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2026. Additional information will be provided on the CLFV2026 website.

## Venue

The conference will take place at the Main Campus of Sapienza University of Rome. Sapienza is the largest university in Europe, with 122,000 students, and one of the oldest, having been founded in 1303.

The Sapienza Main Campus (known as *Città Universitaria*) is easily accessible by public transport, within walking distance of Rome's central railway station Roma Termini and close to three stations of metro line B.

## How to Reach Sapienza Main Campus

Rome is well connected by air, rail, and public transportation.

- **By plane:** Rome is served by two international airports, *Leonardo da Vinci–Fiumicino (FCO)* and *Ciampino (CIA)*. Both airports are connected to the city center by train, bus, and taxi services.
- **By train:** The Main Campus is located approximately 1 km from *Roma Termini*, the main railway station, which is served by national and international trains (and connected directly to Fiumicino airport)
- **By public transport:** Sapienza Main Campus is connected to the local public transport network through the Roma Termini hub and other bus, tram and metro routes.

Detailed directions to the conference venue and practical travel information will be made available on the conference website.

## Accommodation

Participants are kindly requested to arrange their own accommodation. Early booking is strongly recommended, as June is a high tourist season in Rome. Popular hotel booking sites offer a wide choice of Hotels and B&B near Sapienza Main Campus. A selection of accommodation options will be advertised on the conference website.

## Travel and Visa information

Practical travel information and visa requirements will be posted on the conference website. Participants requiring a visa are encouraged to check requirements well in advance.

## **Social Program**

The conference dinner will be held on Thursday, 18 June 2026.

A guided excursion is being planned at participants' own expenses.
