- Il Nuovo Cimento (Italian Physical Society)
- Journal de Physique (EDP Sciences/ French Physical Society)
- Zeitschrift für Physik (Springer)

...back in 1998.



Why EPJ?

Sort of "Treaty of Rome" in physics publishing

...someone had to start

- Reduce the number of overall titles, strengthen an international, European-based platform



- EPJ is published in 7 sections
  - EPJ A Hadrons and Nuclei (1998)
  - EPJ B Cond. Matter and Complex Systems (1998)
  - EPJ C Particles and Fields (1998)
  - EPJ D Atomic, Mol., Opt. and Plasma Phys. (1998)
  - EPJ E Soft Matter (2000)
  - EPJ AP Applied Physics (1998)
  - EPJ ST Special Topics (2007)
  - Further sections in preparation
