SuperB DIRAC module installation status



- SuperB DIRAC → prototype
 - <https://github.com/managai/SuperB DIRAC> (testing purpose)
 - https://github.com/managai/DIRAC_tmp (testing purpose)
 - add menu in webportal named "Production Manager" and a new named "Home"
- Installation procedure customized
 - Works well but...
 - Install only vanilla DIRAC
 - SuperB DIRAC downloaded but not installed
- Support requested to developers
 - Received new tips and suggestions to consider...



SuperB DIRAC module installation status



- VMDIRAC installation test
 - VMDIRAC offered as official DIRAC extension
 - In theory, just editing installation .cfg file the module should be installed
 - In practice, still experiencing troubles
 - Same results trying to install SuperB DIRAC module
 - Once solved VMDIRAC installation procedure, SuperB DIRAC should be installed using same tips
 - Intense email interaction with DIRAC developers
 - Especially Adrian Casajus, Andrei Tsaregorodtsev, Matvey Sapunov
 - Solution seems close...
 - I hope :)



SuperB DIRAC module installation status



- Some considerations:
 - Webportal pages can be added directly editing DIRAC files
 - See Rafael works
 - Services, agents and Databases can be added in the same easy way ?
 - Test needed
 - SuperB DIRAC installation task fundamental for future
 - At present time, failure on this task can slow development of custom code



SuperBDIRAC module installation status



- Backup solution proposal
 - Fork entire DIRAC repo
 - Modify DIRAC
 - Webportal
 - Adding Systems, Services, Agents, Dbs, scripts needed in the right places
 - Custom installation procedure to install our own forked DIRAC version
 - Successfully tested
 - Consider it only a possible temporary solution
 - Useful to test new components
 - We must be ready to switch to SuperBDIRAC project
 - Only matter of SVN usage
 - Plus same configuration file I have to carefully edit

- Replicate WebUI menu and page structure
 - https://bbr-serv09.cr.cnaf.infn.it:8443/~webui_sbk5/
- Main menu:
 - Production System (instead of SuperB)
 - Page: Home
 - Menu: Sessions
 - Page: sites management
 - Menu: FastSim
 - [See WebUI for pages]
 - Menu: FullSim
 - [See WebUI for pages]
- Configure properly permissions to page access
 - VOMSRole mapped via dirac group (see backup slide)



Milestone proposal



- October
 - SuperB DIRAC installation
 - SBK5 insert query via SQLAlchemy
 - Sbkprodrhas only read permission
 - Write and update permission necessary to replicate Site Management page
- October
 - Transformation System testing
 - Should be useful for workflow and Massive Data Transfers
 - Site Management porting under SuperB DIRAC
 - First FastSim job submission via SuperB DIRAC
 - Prototype (Expert or Shift) Init page
- November
 - Manage permission rules for Operations via SuperB DIRAC web interface
 - Production Requests page
 - Monitoring functionalities in SuperB DIRAC
- December
 - SuperB DIRAC able to perform complete MC production stack

Collaborative tools update

 - Uploaded SuperBDIRAC module
 - Uploaded Severus (modified to work with DIRAC)

- Severus/version24/modules/fileManager.py
 - Line 109
 - Original
 - *out = self.lcgUtil.lfcLs(path)*
 - Modified
 - *out = self.lcgUtils.lcgLs(path)*
 - Why?: Workaround because surl starting with lfn:/ supposed to be accessed from CNAF (so Severus drop initial lfn:/ from surl and try to access input file locally)

- DIRAC job wrapper install its own python environment
 - Python version 2.6.6
- Severus tested to work with Python 2.4
 - Severus perform an intial python version check
 - Version24 directory contains all components
- Proposal
 - Test modified Severus with Python 2.6
 - New code under version26 directory
 - Modify severus.py to enable Python 2.6 usage

- SBK5 queries to be prepared - via SQLAlchemy and/or REST interface
 - SELECT count(runnum) as tot FROM "<session_name>"_Job " WHERE (prod_series = '<prod_series>') AND (runnum BETWEEN "<minrun>" AND "<maxrun>") AND (status!='prepared');
 - SELECT * FROM "<session_name>"_Job " WHERE (prod_series = '<prod_series>') AND runnum = '<runnum>';
 - UPDATE "<session_name>"_Job SET grid_job_id = "<job_id>", status = 'submitted', ts_submitted = cast(now) as timestamp(0) WHERE prod_series = '<prod_series>' AND runnum = "<runnum>" AND status = 'prepared';
 - UPDATE "<session_name>"_Submission SET bulk_job_id || ('<site>' => '<bulk_job_id>') WHERE uid = '<uid>' AND ts_prepared = '<timestamp>';



MC production via SuperB DIRAC



- Issue: SuperB DIRAC/ProductionSystem need to interact with SBK5
 - N.B. Now Severus can be properly launched only from CNAF (?)
 - SBK5 psql-like access only from CNAF
 - SBK5 access outside CNAF only via REST interface
 - Solution proposal:
 - Create a Service (temporary named SBK5Service) into SuperB DIRAC to cope (all?) SBK5 queries
 - Each site equipped with a DIRAC server and SBK5Service must be able to directly query SBK5
 - Enhance SBK5 REST interface by adding some views to simply perform needed queries from every DIRAC Server Instance
 - No changes to SBK5 access policy

- DIRAC webportal must replicate all WebUI features
- DIRAC/WebUI operations
 - Production creation → write
 - Production data retrieve → read
 - Request creation → write
 - Request data retrieve → read
 - Bulk job creation → write
 - Bulk job submission → read data for Severus
- Severus job wrapper
 - Job status report → write
 - Job Log registration → write



DIRAC API



- DIRAC offers a powerful set of API
 - We need a good quality documentation to speed up development
- API documentation
 - <http://diracgrid.org/files/docs/CodeDocumentation/API/index.html>
 - Epydoc generated – updated – maintained by developers
