The first “Ages of Stars” meeting was held in Baltimore, Maryland in 2008.

Real progress has been made in the field since then, and ages² is an opportunity to review what has been accomplished and where effort is needed. Among the subjects to be discussed are:

Ages of clusters and age spreads, and ages of small stellar groups • Ages of pre-main-sequence stars • Ages of the oldest stars and clusters • Ages of low-mass stars and brown dwarfs • Ages of evolved stars and applying them to Galactic archaeology • The current state of stellar models • Ages of solar-like stars from seismology and implications for gyrochronology • Star-formation histories in the Local Group
