SECOND CIRCULAR

The "5th International Meeting of Union for Compact Accelerator-driven Neutron Sources, UCANS-V" will be held from 12th to 15th May 2015, at the INFN Laboratori Nazionali di Legnaro, Legnaro, ITALY. The meeting is organized by the Istituto Nazionale di Fisica Nucleare (INFN) with the patronage of the University of Padova.

The registration and opening session will begin at 15:00 on Tuesday, May 12, in the *Archivio Antico* Hall at Palazzo Bo, the historical building of the University of Padova, one of Europe's oldest university, dating back to 1222. A welcome cocktail will follow.

From May 13th to 15th the meeting will be held at Laboratori Nazionali di Legnaro of the INFN. Legnaro is located 10 km (6 miles) from Padova.

SCOPE OF THE WORKSHOP

In recent years large scale neutron facilities have been constructed and are now fully in operation. Others are in the final stage of the construction or are planned for the near future. A new generation of high current accelerators has opened new perspectives for the development of advanced compact neutron generators/sources with neutron beams tailored to specific activities in various fields of work based on neutrons. These compact sources will play key roles; they can be used for tests of new methods, devices and training.

The activities of compact accelerator-based neutron facilities cover nowadays almost all fields of applied and fundamental science, including materials science, engineering, cancer therapy, radiation damage, nuclear astrophysics, cross section measurements, etc.

Related to the design, construction and operation of these compact neutron facilities, other spinoffs are generated in many ancillary fields, e.g. accelerators, beam optics, neutron production targets, heat removal designs, neutron moderators, neutron transport, neutron detection, electronics, and many others.

The effective impact of compact neutron facilities in modern science and technology is strongly connected to the development of a network based community supported by periodic international meetings and collaborative programs. The UCANS meetings provide valuable opportunities for users and coordinators of compact neutron facilities to exchange information related to various neutron-based and diverse ancillary fields in an informal and friendly setting.

The first UCANS meeting (http://www.ucans.org/), was inaugurated in 2009 at Tsinghua University in Beijing, China, followed by subsequent meetings in the following years in Bloomington (USA), Bilbao (Spain) and Sapporo (Japan). The UCANS-V in 2015 will be hosted by the Laboratori Nazionali di Legnaro (LNL) of the Istituto Nazionale di Fisica Nucleare (INFN).

TOPICS

- A. Accelerators and beam optics;
- B. Target radiation damage and heat removal;
- C. Moderator neutronics;
- D. Optical devices;
- E. Neutron detection;
- F. Innovative instrumentation;
- G. Material characterization;
- H. Other neutron applications based on CANS;
- I. Nuclear astrophysics;
- J. Nuclear data measurements and evaluation;
- K. Medical applications;
- L. Computer simulations of CANS, instrument performance and data-analysis software.

We also welcome presentations from large facilities, to foster cross-fertilization and joint complementary R&D between compact and large facilities, as well as presentations from developers of small, high current, low energy accelerators. We also encourage friendly discussions on CANS' roles, users' desires, collaborative schemes, education/training, and so on.

SCIENTIFIC PROGRAMME

The scientific programme will consist of invited/contributed and oral/poster presentations focusing on the above listed topics (A-L).

Authors are invited to submit abstracts for oral and/or poster presentations using the Indico web-interface. A template of the abstract can be downloaded from the UCANS-V Meeting website.

The deadline for submitting abstracts is February 15, 2015.

The Programme Committee will select contributions for oral or poster presentations. Authors will be notified about the acceptance of their contribution and type of presentation by **March 9, 2015**.

The abstracts will be published in the Book of Abstracts, on condition that the presenting author has a valid Conference registration. The Book of Abstracts will be available for all registered attendees.

VENUE and TRAVEL

The opening session on May 12, 2015 will take place at Palazzo Bo, the historical building of the University of Padova, Via VIII Febbraio 2, Padova. From May 13 to May 15 the meeting will be held at the Laboratori Nazionali di Legnaro of the INFN, Viale dell'Università 2, Legnaro (Padova), Italy. Legnaro is only 10 Km (6 miles) from Padova and 30 km (20 miles) from Venice. Details on transportation and routes to Legnaro are available on the meeting web page.

A bus service between the hotels in Padova and Legnaro will be organized daily for Conference participants.

ACCOMMODATION

The list of hotels is available on the Conference website. The hotels are close to the center of Padova Participants are kindly invited to contact directly the hotels, but please take notice that May is high season and we suggest to book your room as soon as possible.
